1. Schedule and venue

The tournament will be held in Alixares Hotel****, place in Paseo de la Sabica nº40, 14, Granada.

2. Capacity

Tournament limited to 400 players, in strict order of registration. This will not be considered carried out until proof of payment of the fee is received.

Once the limit is exceeded, those who request it will be placed on a waiting list and will be added to the list of participants if there are any withdrawals.

3. System of play

- Swiss system with 9 rounds. At the start of the game, each player will have 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move.
- Pairings will be carried out using the Swiss Manager software.
- The initial ranking will be based on the FIDE Elo rating from the latest published list (July 2026). If a player does not have a FIDE Elo rating, their last published FADA (regional) Elo rating will be used for ranking. If they do not have an Elo rating, they will be placed below players with any of the mentioned ratings and ordered alphabetically.

4. Authorized Byes

Players may request in writing up to THREE (3) half-point byes in the first 6 rounds, provided the request is made before the publication of the round for which the bye is requested. Players invited by the organization may not use this exemption unless there is a justified reason (e.g., illness).

5. Delay

A player will be considered absent from a round if they fail to appear within 30 minutes after the arbiter announces the start of the games for that round.

6. Disqualifications

A player will be disqualified for the following reasons:

- a. Failure to appear for a paired game unless they submit a written request to the organization to continue in the tournament, also stating the reason for their absence.
- b. Failure to appear for two games, with no possibility of continuing.
- c. Serious misconduct

7. Appeals Committee

A decision made by the Chief Arbiter may be appealed to the Appeals Committee in writing within 30 minutes after the conclusion of the relevant game, in accordance with the Laws of Chess. Penalties unrelated to the game, decided by the Chief Arbiter, may also be appealed within 30 minutes of their notification.

To submit an appeal, a deposit of €50 must be paid, which will be refunded if the appeal is successful or, even if unsuccessful, if the Appeals Committee deems that there were reasonable grounds for its submission.

The Committee will be composed of the Tournament Director (or their substitute), who will have the casting vote, and four players (two main members and two substitutes), all of whom must be of legal age and hold an arbiter title. If the committee cannot be fully formed, additional players with an Elo rating above 1900 (according to the initial ranking) will be designated as needed.

9. Registration and fees
