REGULATIONS

1. VENUE AND DATES

1.1 Venue: Salón Vienés, Hotel Camino Real, Ave. La Reforma and 14 Calle, Zone 10, Guatemala City.

1.2 Dates: January 6–10, 2027.

2. CATEGORY: Open - limited to 155 players (The organizing committee reserves the right of admission).

3. REGISTRATION

3.1 Special Conditions

3.1.1 Free registration for Grand Masters (GM y WGM) and International Masters (MI y WMI)

3.1.2 Accommodation will be provided to the first five Grandmasters (with a FIDE rating above 2450 at the time of registration) who confirm their registration and send proof of airline ticket reservation to torneointernacionalclubCaissa@gmail.com. Confirmation of this status will be sent via email. Grandmasters who receive this benefit are required to play all games

3.2. Payment. Payments in Quetzales should be made to the CAISSA Guatemala NGO account #018-0008584-5 at Banco G&T Continental. Payments from abroad will be made via PayPal (registration fee plus commission). Please send an email to torneointernacionalclubCaissa@gmail.com to receive a PayPal payment request.

3.3. Registration. All registrations – without exception – must be made by depositing the fee into the account indicated in section 3.2 and sending an email to torneointernacionalclubCaissa@gmail.com by January 3, 2027, attaching the following information: 1) a scanned copy of the deposit slip or transfer receipt, 2) full name, 3) passport-style photo, 4) place of origin, 5) FIDE identification number, 6) whether a bye is required and which round, and 7) age and a copy of birth certificate if the participant is a minor. It is important to receive your registration confirmation.

3.4. Payment receipts. To request your payment receipt, please send an email to the address indicated in section 3.3, attaching a copy of the deposit slip, specifying the name of the person to be issued the receipt, and indicating the chess player whose name is on the deposit. This must be done before January 5th so that the receipts can be distributed during the event.

3.5. Accreditation. All participants must wear their badge throughout the event. Badges will be provided on the first day of the tournament.

3.6 REGISTRATION FEE FOR PLAYERS WITH FIDE RATING: (local participants must deposit in quetzales)

USD \$70 or Q535 until September 15, 2026

USD \$80 or Q615 from September 16, 2026

USD \$90 or Q690 from November 16, 2026

USD \$100 or Q765 for players without FIDE rating (10 player limit – then they will go to a waiting list)



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CAISSA club members (active and up to date) receive a 25% discount if they have paid 6 consecutive dues in 2026.

4. COMPETITION SYSTEM.

- 4.1. Swiss system. 9 rounds.
- 4.2. 90 minutes plus 30 seconds of increment per move for each player.
- 4.3. Draw system; 1) Direct encounter 2) Bucholz cut 1 3) Bucholz total y 4) Rating performance 5) More victories
- 4.4. The official FIDE Swiss Manager pairing program will be used, and the results of each round will be published immediately after the official printing. Any discrepancies in the results must be reported to the chief arbiter before the start of the relevant round. Inasistencias: 30 min. de espera.
- 4.5. Absences: Only one absence is allowed and it must be justified. (First round pairings will only be made with players present in the room)
- 4.6. Up to two byes (BYE) may be requested exclusively for rounds 1 and 3, in which case half a point will be awarded per bye. Requests must be made at least 24 hours before the tournament begins.
- 4.7. During the game, any type of electronic device is prohibited; bringing it into the game room may result in a penalty of losing the game.
- 4.8. *It is forbidden to agree to a draw before 25 moves or during the first hour of play*
- 4.9. An appeals committee (3 people with knowledge of FIDE rules) will be formed at the start of the tournament.

- 6.3 Special prizes are based on FIDE Elo ratings in blocks. For example, the sub-2300 prize will be for players with FIDE Elo ratings between 2299 and 2100, and so on.
- 6.4 Players without a FIDE rating, their local rating applies for prize purposes.
